

PROPOSED "DEMOLITION DELAY ORDINANCE" NEEDS YOUR SUPPORT!



Demolition of 608 West Green Street, Urbana

What it **DOES**:

Requires 45-day delay period between application for demolition permit and issuance of permit

Provides window of opportunity to conduct architectural/historical research on building to determine eligibility for local or national landmark status

Allows time to prepare nomination for landmark status for consideration by Urbana's Historic Preservation Commission or other entities

Identifies historically/architecturally important structures that have not been recognized and provides basis for protection/preservation

What it **DOES NOT DO**:

DOES NOT: Prohibit applications for demolition permits

DOES NOT: Prohibit demolitions if no landmark nominations are submitted

DOES NOT: Prohibit demolition if nominated structures do not meet landmark criteria

DOES NOT: Burden city staff with expenses related to historic/architectural research for landmark nominations. Research would be **VOLUNTARILY** conducted by concerned individuals, **NOT** city staff.
